FORTIFIED Home Requirements for Homes with Excessive Gaps **Between Wood Decking Boards**

Introduction

There are increasing requests for guidance from evaluators and contractors about existing wood board roof decking which has gaps that exceed 1/8 inch. This technical bulletin provides guidance for asphalt shingle roofs that should be followed when these conditions are present to comply with the 2025 FORTIFIED Home™ Standard.

Installation Requirements

FORTIFIED standards, asphalt shingle manufacturers, and many municipalities require shingles to be installed over a solidly sheathed roof deck. The interpretation of "solidly sheathed" is not clearly defined in the code or consistently identified by shingle manufacturers.




Figure 1: Standard Detail F-RR-5





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FORTIFIED requires wood structural panel overlay to be installed over existing roof deck boards with gaps greater than 1/8 inch, or if the roof cover manufacturer has specific guidance that allows for gaps greater than 1/8 inch, then up to 1/4 inch maximum gaps between boards are allowed in compliance with manufacturer guidance. However, in any case where gaps between boards exceed 1/4 inch, wood structural panel overlay must be installed.

For installation of wood structural panel overlay, prescriptive FORTIFIED Standard Detail F-RR-5 may be followed, or overlay may be installed in compliance with a site-specific professional engineering design.

Compliance Verification Requirements

- Provide 4 photos from different areas from the topside of the bare roof deck, with tape measure, showing gap width.
- Refer to the Documentation Requirements checklist and provide all required photos listed for roof deck attachment.
- If the roof cover manufacturer's guidance allows for gaps greater than 1/8 in., include their published guidance with the evaluation, along with the roof deck attachment photos.
 - Board decking with spaces greater than 1/4 inch are not eligible for a FORTIFIED Designation
